CAUSES	 Heavy condensation Excessive heat due to lime build up above thermostat probe

	Anode rod not installed in heater		
	Softening to zero parts per million		
	Stray voltage grounded to heater		
Deliming	Heavy mineral deposits in bottom of tank	see Bulletin 13
